

How to Sort and Put Garbage out

Towards an environmentally friendly town through recycling



Let's work on "garbage diet"

Let's work on "garbage diet" together with all the Furano residents!



We can reduce the environmental impact and treatment costs by properly sorting our garbage.

Please put garbage out at the designated garbage station by 9:00 a.m. (by 8:00 a.m. for rural village districts) on the collection days.

1 Plastic

This garbage group is for bags, containers and trays with this mark on them. Please place them into the designated bag and put it out at the garbage station.

Polystyrene cups, Styrofoam, Instant noodle cups, Tofu containers, Frozen food packages, Snack wrappers, Plastic wrap, Detergent bottles, Shampoo bottles, Packed lunch containers from convenience stores, Grocery bags, Pill packages, Squeezeable tubes, Egg cartons, Packaging & wrappers, Plastic bags, Yogurt containers.

- Rinse with water...
- Allow to dry...
- ...and place into the designated bag and put it out at the garbage station!

You can put out plastic caps with other plastics!

2 PET Bottles

This garbage group is for bottles with this mark on them. Please place them into the designated bag and put it out at the garbage station.

- Remove the cap...
- Rinse with water...
- Flatten the bottles and place them into the designated bag to put out at the garbage station.

Plastic caps go into the Plastic Garbage Group.
Metal caps go into the Metal Garbage Group.

You can place many bottles in one bag by flattening them.

3 Food Waste

This garbage group includes organic garbage such as domestic food and kitchen waste. Shells and bones can go into this group. Please place them into the designated bag and put it out at the garbage station.

Allow them to dry.

4 Cans

This garbage group is for steel cans and aluminum cans. Please place them into the designated bag and put it out at the garbage station.

* Metal caps go to the Metal Garbage Group. Please place them into a clear plastic bag and put out.

Metals

This garbage group includes spray cans, pans, spoons, metal caps, kitchen knives, razors and lighters. Please place them into a clear plastic bag and put it out at the garbage station.

* For safety, please wrap knives and other bladed objects before putting them out.

5 Bottles, Ceramics and Glass

Clear bottles, Brown bottles, Bottles of other colors.

Glass, Ceramics, Cosmetic bottles, Thermos pots.

* Plastic caps go into the Plastic Garbage Group.
* Metal caps go into the Metal Garbage Group.

These go into the designated containers.

Please sort bottles by color and place them into designated bottle bins.

6 Combustible Garbage

This garbage group includes paper scraps, paper containers, plastics with no recycling mark on them, clothing, cloth, leather products, rubber products, cigarette waste, dust, cotton and other combustible materials. Please place them into the designated bag and put it out at the garbage station.

7 Hygiene Products

This garbage group includes diapers, sanitary products and toilet products for pets. Please place them into the designated bag and put it out at the garbage station.

8 Newspapers, Magazines & Cardboard

Please bundle them together with string and put them out at the garbage station (you can also use the designated bag for newspapers).

Newspapers and leaflets, Magazines, Cardboard, Milk cartons.

9 Ash

Pour water... Ashes

Clear plastic bag

10 Animal Bodies

Please consult the City Office.

11 Batteries & Fluorescent Lights

Batteries and thermometers...
Fluorescent lights and bulbs...

...go into the collection box.
...shall be taken back to electric shops.

12 Garden Waste

Please put grass, leaves and sticks into a clear plastic bag and put it out at the garbage station.

Please bundle sticks together with straw rope or hemp rope and put them out at the garbage station.

1 meter or less
40 cm or less

13 Large Items and Electric Appliances

Large items: sofa, bed, etc.

Electric appliances: vacuum, fan, etc.

* To dispose of large items, electric appliances and small electric goods, please purchase disposal tickets at the City Office or at the branch office. Please put these items by your doorstep on the designated collection date (once a month).

* Please place small electric goods in the designated bag (fee required) to discharge them.

14 Dangerous Waste

Furano City is unable to collect these items. Please contact the place of purchase regarding disposal.

Fire extinguisher, Unused paint, Tires, Waste oil, Pesticides/herbicides, Construction debris, Batteries, Propane gas cylinders.
